

Scholarship Program

If you are moving beyond secondary education by attending Morris or Benedict College, the Woman's Pee Dee District Department of the Pee Dee Missionary Baptist Association can assist you financially. There will be two (1 for each school) scholarships awarded annually to deserving students who attend Morris College and Benedict College.

The Woman's Pee Dee District Department Scholarship is awarded to any member of a Pee Dee Baptist church who is a high school senior or is attending or planning to attend either Benedict or Morris College.

Scholarship Guidelines

The Woman's Pee Dee District Department of the Pee Dee Missionary Baptist Association will award a scholarship each year to two (2) students (one student attending Benedict College and one student attending Morris College. This scholarship will only be awarded to a recipient once. The guidelines to qualify for the scholarship are as follows:

- ☐ The applicant must be a member of a church that is an active member of the Pee Dee Missionary Baptist Association.
- ☐ The student must complete an application packet in its entirety.
- ☐ The grade point average (GPA) of the student must be at least a C+.
- ☐ An official copy of the high school/college transcript must be submitted by the applicant to verify grades.
- □ A Letter of Recommendation, on church letterhead, from the student's pastor and church school superintendent must be submitted.
- ☐ A signed Letter of Recommendation from the high school guidance counselor or the college advisor must accompany the application.
- ☐ The student must submit a typed one page essay on "How Will A college Education Help Me to Achieve My Life's Goals?" (Must use a 12 point font size)

Scholarship Guidelines Continued

- ☐ Recipients will be selected by the Woman's Pee Dee District Department Scholarship Committee.
- ☐ The scholarship will be sent directly to the college after the student has been notified by the committee and officially enrolled. The scholarship can also be used for any item associated with academics at the college.
