Scholarship Guidelines

The Pee Dee Missionary Baptist Association will award two (2) scholarships each year to students attending Morris or Benedict Colleges. The guidelines to qualify for the scholarship are as follows:

- 1. The applicant must be a member of a church that is an active member of the Pee Dee Missionary Baptist Association.
- 2. The student must complete an application packet.
- 3. The grade point average (GPA) of the student must be at least a C+.
- 4. An official copy of the high school/college transcript must be submitted by the applicant to verify grades.
- 5. A Letter of Recommendation, on church letterhead, from the student's pastor and church school superintendent must be submitted.
- 6. A signed Letter of Recommendation from the high school guidance counselor or the college advisor must accompany the application.
- 7. The student must submit a typed one page essay on "What it Means to Be Successful."
- 8. Recipients will be selected by the Pee Dee Missionary Baptist Association Scholarship Committee.
- 9. The scholarship will be sent directly to the college after the student has officially enrolled.
